Provides direction for the children in the classroom, and implements program curriculum. Provides a quality experience to children and parents that focuses on building achievement and belonging in youth and relationships among youth and within families.

  - a. This certificate is valid for two years and it is your responsibility to keep it up to date.
- 4. Complete Child Abuse Prevention Training within 30 days of your hire date.
  - a. This training is required annually throughout your employment.
- 5. Previous experience working with children in a developmental setting preferred.
- 6. Ability to plan, organize and implement age-appropriate/developmentally appropriate program activities.
- 7. Previous experience with diverse populations preferred. Ability to develop positive, authentic relationships with people from different backgrounds.
- 8. Understands the YMCA is a public accommodation committed to inclusion and compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
